Health and Personal Information – Be honest how you answer the questions in this section as they may have serious implications for your safety and insurance. Please make sure to include details of any dietary restrictions (vegetarian, no fish, etc). In the section about previous travel, please include any countries you have travelled to so far, for how long and why (for family holidays, school trips, etc.)

Supporting statement – As it is the only place where you get a chance to tell us, in your own words, about why you should be accepted onto the programme, the supporting statement is an important part of your application.

It is important that you try to write the supporting statement yourself (without help from parents, teachers, etc.) and that you take time to think about the four questions we ask you to address.

If typed the supporting statement should be at least one page long (longer if hand-written).

If you decide to write your supporting statement by hand, please make sure that you write clearly and legibly, using a black or blue pen.

Terms and Conditions – The Terms and Conditions contain important information about the programme, so please make sure you read them carefully before signing your application form. You should keep the terms and conditions page for future reference, do not send it back to us. Should you be called to interview, you will be asked to confirm that you have read and understood the terms and conditions.

References – You need to ask two people who are familiar with your personality and experience to complete the reference forms attached to the application form. (These can be posted to us directly by the referee or submitted along with the rest of your application.) Please note that you should get both references from people who are able to give an objective assessment of your suitability for the programme. For this reason, please do not ask a personal friend, relative, colleague or family friend to act as your referee. Examples of suitable referees might be current or past teachers, employers, sports coaches or religious leaders. Your referees should have known you for at least 1 year.

Terms and Conditions

Acceptance on to the Programme

To apply for the programme you must put forward a completed application to Islamic Help. Your approval on to the programme will be judged on your eligibility, your written application, interview and two references.

Confirmation of your place will be made by email or by notifying through a phone call.

Islamic Help reserves the right to discard any applicant at any phase of the application process. In such cases warning will be made in writing via e-mail. The purpose of this type of programme is to provide volunteers with real first-hand experience of a developing country.

Briefing and Express Days

All volunteers are required to attend briefings before they depart and Express days after they return to the UK.

Medical

Volunteers are required to complete a medical questionnaire, the results of which will be looked at when considering the applicants.

Accommodation

Volunteers accept that they will stay somewhere to live of which will be in harmony with local standards. This is likely to be significantly more basic than in the UK. The housing, furniture, cooking facilities, are all likely to be of a lower standard than you are used to.

Visas

Visas are issued at the discretion of the Tanzanian Embassy and High Commission. This will be arranged by Islamic Help.

Passport

It is your accountability to ensure that you have a UK passport with at least six months validity beyond the date of your return flight.

Flights

Islamic Help will arrange return flights from Birmingham. Wherever possible we will try to accommodate. You are required to fly out and back with the group on the dates given.

Insurance

You will be provided with a travel insurance policy prior to your departure which will be valid for the period of your programme. It is important that you answer the health questions on the application form (page 5) honestly.

Cancellation

If there is any reason why you may need to cancel your trip, please contact us as soon as possible to discuss it in confidence so that we can limit our financial losses as much as possible. If you do cancel without pre-warning, you may be liable to pay to cover certain costs.

Volunteer Conduct

By joining this programme you agree:

- To act in a responsible and considerate manner at all times
- To observe the local laws and customs of the country
- To adhere to acceptable behaviour, timekeeping and dress code
- Not to act in any manner likely to bring the programme, the locals or Islamic Help into ill repute.

In our programme it is not socially acceptable for people to drink alcohol.

Personal information

Your personal records will be treated confidentially.

Islamic Help reserves the right to speak freely about your health, well-being and conduct whilst on the programme. Please inform a member of the team if you would prefer us not to do so.

CRB Check

Due to some of our projects including work with young children all participants will be CRB checked. Any offences on participant's records will be looked at on an individual basis and will not result in a definite rejection on the Mission Possible programme.

All records gained from the CRB checks will be dealt with confidentially and no details will be released.

What we require from you

- An agreement to raise £5,000
- Involvement in any events organised by Islamic Help such as dinners, appeals and street collections for the Mafia cause.

Recordings and Pictures

- We will be documenting this deployment and all participants must agree with their requirements regarding filming, interviews etc.
- All work orientated pictures taken on this deployment will be given to Islamic Help towards the end of the deployment for Islamic Help's usage for promotion and publicity for future events.

Rights and liabilities

1. Any images and video taken of me while on the programme, I waive any rights for Islamic Help to use them.
2. I will not hold Islamic Help, its partners or employees liable for any loss, damage, personal injury, delay or expense suffered or incurred by me for any reason.
